that I Joseph J. Hopkins of said county in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from Slavery, liberated manumitted and set free my negro woman named Minty aged about forty three years Louiza aged about fourteen & their heirs forever, all of which are able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance & the said negroes named I do declare to be free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my executors administrators or assigns forever. In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 25<sup>th</sup> May 1832
